DAY 1

10:30 am

Arrive at McCourtie Park, located on the edge of the Irish Hills, off US-12, in Somerset Center, MI. Having the opportunity to meander through McCourtie Park, and learn about its history, is a truly unique experience. There are seventeen bridges, criss-crossing a stream that meanders through the park, no two alike. Each bridge is made of cement, painstakingly carved, by hand, to look like logs, planks, and ropes, by two artisans, from Mexico. In addition to the stream and bridges, there are two spring fed ponds, originally used for swimming and trout fishing, two unique birdhouses, and rolling green areas to enjoy. 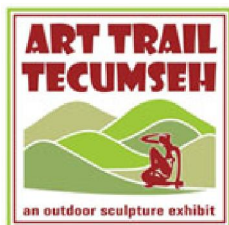

Board the bus for a relaxing ½ hour ride to Hidden Lake Gardens, a 750+ acre arboretum, owned and maintained by Michigan State University, located in Tipton, MI. Spend the day exploring Hidden Lake Gardens, which consists of year-round indoor and outdoor garden collections, a wonderful conservatory, the beautiful lake area, woodlands, open grass meadows, formal gardens and trees, shrubs and flowers, from all over the world, including Bonsai and rare Conifers, plus a multi-purpose visitor center, and a lovely gift shop. Wheelchair user trails and year-round educational programs, for all ages, are always available at HLG.

In the morning, when you arrive, enjoy a docent-directed tour of the gardens and conservatory, including a leisurely drive along the 7-mile viewing road. Following the tour, and depending on the time of year, enjoy lunch, mid-day, catered by a local restaurant, served outside, under a tent, on the garden grounds, or inside, in the indoor meeting room. Following a lovely lunch, provided by a local restaurant, enjoy an informative seminar or workshop, tailored to the group's particular interests, spend time further exploring the conservatory and the gift shop or wander the gardens and grounds at your own pace.
